

## Lodging 2012

### Speyer University has got two dormitories:

- All rooms are non-smoking rooms.
- Rooms will be cleaned regularly
- Bedclothes are provided by the DHV
- All rooms are equipped with internet access, shower and WC
- Rooms have no TV-connection
- Towels are not provided
- Washing machines and laundry dryers (both operated with coins), drying rooms and ironing equipment are available in the basement of the dormitories.

### Dormitory 1:

- Completely renovated in 2002.
  - 56 double rooms (26 m<sup>2</sup>) available, two rooms were especially refurbished for handicapped persons
  - The rental charge is as follows:
    - € 260,-/person/month in a single room and
    - € 130,-/person/month in a double room
- Double rooms may be rented as single rooms

### Dormitory 2:

- Located at the west side of the campus
- Single rooms with private shower and WC (approx. 18 m<sup>2</sup>), most of them with a balcony
- Tea kitchen and refrigerator (to be shared by all students) on each floor
- Phone with fax (to be operated by a card) available on the first floor
- Rental fee for single room in the guest house is € 270,- / month

## Internet Access Information

### Wired network connection (LAN)

Wired network connection can be accessed with a standard-Ethernet cable (CAT 5 patch cable with a RJ45 plug) in the service area of the library and in the rooms of the dormitory. The cable (5 Euro) and plug adapters can be purchased at the IT department of the Speyer University.

### Power network adapter for your notebooks

You can buy those adapters for Germany either in the United States before your trip to Germany or in a shop here in Speyer.

### Wireless network connection (WLAN)

There are several access points on the campus:

- in the Service area of the library (SSID: "**Bibliothek**")
- in the lobby of the Dormitory 2 (SSID: "**Gaestehaus**")
- in the university lobby (main building), in the AudiMax (lecture hall) and in the Aula (auditorium) (SSID: "**Aula**")
- in the cafeteria (SSID: "**Taberna**")
- on the first floor of Dormitory 1 (SSID: "**Wohnheim**")

The WLAN can only be used in a security mode with **data encryption (WEPactivated)**. On the first connection to any given wireless network, a security key must be entered and then confirmed.

**This procedure is separate for each WLAN but needs to be performed only once.**

The security key is the same for all WLANs: **badfee1947**
